Re : **PSA TEST, SCHOOL MAGAZINE & CBSE SCIENCE EXHIBITION 2014-2015:**

- PROBLEM SOLVING ASSESSMENT (PSA) FOR 2014-2015:** The PSA test for 2014-2015 will be held on **Thursday i.e. 20th November, 2014** for Std.IX, X and XI. PSA, assesses the skills of verbal communication, analytical reasoning, critical thinking, creative thinking, decision making and generic skills which play a crucial role for every individual to be successful in personal as well as professional life.
 - It is compulsory for all students of Std.IX and XI.
 - Students studying in Std.X in the current session who appeared in PSA while studying in Std.IX during 2013-2014 who wish to improve in PSA can appear for the test.
 - The test assesses life skills related to the following three domains:
Language conventions, qualitative reasoning and quantitative reasoning.
 - It comprises of a total of 60 items of MCQ type and carries 60 marks.
 - The test will be held from **10.00 A.M. to 12.00 noon on 20.11.2014.**
 - PSA score will be counted towards FA-4 which is 10% of total assessments for Std.IX. This score will be reflected equally in one language (English or Hindi), Mathematics, Science and Social Science. Std.XI students will be issued a separate Certificate for the same.
- SCHOOL MAGAZINE "INTO LIGHT – 2014-2015":** The School Magazine "INTO LIGHT - 2014-2015" will be published at the end of the Academic Year as informed vide our Circular No.07276 dated 17.02.2014.
